Copenhagen at a Glance

Situated at the entrance to the Baltic Sea, Copenhagen is the capital and most populated city of Denmark, with an urban population of 541,989 which is rising by 1,000 people per month up to 637,000 by 2025. Copenhagen was the winner of the European Green Capital Award in 2014, and it is one of the most environmentally friendly cities in the world with a long term and holistic environmental planning policy.

Malmö at a Glance

Malmö is the largest city of the Swedish county of Skåne County, the third-largest city in Sweden, after Stockholm and Gothenburg, and the sixth-largest city in Scandinavia, with a population of 312,012 inhabitants in 2017 out of a municipal total of 338,230. The Øresund Region, which includes Malmö, is home to four million people. Malmö was one of the earliest and most industrialized towns of Scandinavia, but it struggled with the adaptation to post-industrialism. Since the construction of the Øresund Bridge, Malmö has undergone a major transformation with new architectural developments along its waterfront.
