

Job Description: Program Manager, Workforce Development

Role:

The Program Manager is a results-oriented professional with exceptional organizational skills, leading program implementation design and ongoing delivery of the workforce development and training programs.

Under general direction from executive leadership, the Program Manager will direct the design, implementation, ongoing management and performance of assigned programs and be the first point of escalation for issues. The Program Manager is responsible for meeting program goals including participation and customer service, cost effectiveness and market impacts.

Working closely with staff and external stakeholders, the position will require strong project and budget management skills, a technical aptitude, an ability to monitor, evaluate and report on operational metrics and develop strong relationships with industry and government stakeholders. This role will inform and support strategic planning and business development activities.

Responsibilities:

- Manage program implementation planning and launch, researching implementation options, establishing and maintaining program plans, and ensuring integrated realization of the key deliverables across the program portfolio.
- Manage the delivery of a portfolio of programs including: establishing training courses and calendar, recruiting and retaining program participants, managing delivery contractors/ consultants, program administration, budgeting/budget control, program evaluation, and reporting.
- Provide input to ensure the program portfolio is properly resourced, and manage program delivery staff, including staff and contract resources.
- Identify, implement and manage changes and interventions to ensure project goals are achieved.
- Develop program assessment protocols for evaluation and improvement.
- Conduct research to optimize program design & operations
- Managing risks and issues and taking corrective measurements

- Report overall program status to the steering committee and senior management

Qualifications:
